Can you try increasing the **tempo**; challenge yourself, how fast can you do it?



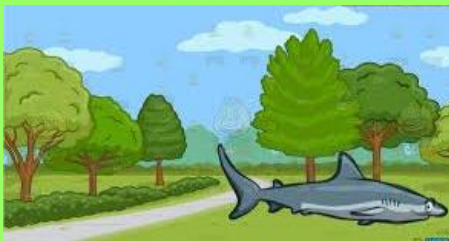
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'Down by the Bay' is a fun song with actions for the chorus, you can learn it here:
