Now click on the Activity: watch how the Captain claps a rhythm then you clap it back... you could also try playing the rhythms with an instrument - tapping / shaking / scraping... Don't forget to 'feel' the heartbeat when you're tapping the rhythms.



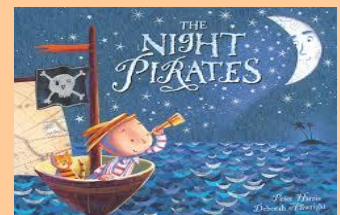
When I was one
