

NURSERY 3 CURRICULUM PLANNER

Communication, Language and Literacy

- Children will be encouraged to listen in small groups to stories, rhymes and poems read aloud
- Children will be encouraged to talk and speak through nursery activities such as role play
- Children will learn nursery rhymes and rhyming songs
- Children will be asked simple 'who', 'what', and 'why' question

WRITING

- Children will be encouraged to make marks for a purpose and put meaning to the marks they make

READING

- We will be reading traditional tales and children's favourite stories:-
 - The Three Little Pigs
 - Goldilocks and the Three Bears
 - Little Red Riding Hood
 - Peace at Last
 - Owl Babies
 - Whatever Next
- We will be singing traditional rhymes with actions
- Supersonic Phonics – Basics 1

Expressive Arts and Design

- Children will be encouraged to use the creative area to paint and collage
- Children will paint self-portraits
- Children will make clay hedgehogs
- After going on an Autumn walk the children will make pictures using natural materials that they have collected
- Children will make 'art' using a variety of different materials
- Children will be encouraged to talk about what they have done
- Weekly music sessions, using simple instruments, singing and dancing

Understanding the World

- Children will be encouraged to talk about their family and themselves
- Children to talk and learn about different types of transport
- Children will experience different celebrations, e.g. Eid, Diwali and Christmas
- Children will learn to develop positive attitudes to differences between people
- We will talk about what is special about us
- We will go on an Autumn walk using all of our senses
- Children will experiment with light in the dark tent
- Den building

Physical Development

- Children will experiment with moving in different ways
- Children will learn to skip, hop, jump and stand on one leg

- A visit to the High Street Library with parents
- Story and Rhyme time for parents
- Christmas Sing a Long for parents
- Children will explore the Forest School
- A walk around the local area

Mathematics

- Children will practice saying numbers in order by counting and singing number rhymes
- Children will begin to show numbers using their fingers
- Children will begin to compare quantities
 - Children to use shapes for a purpose

Computing

- Children will play with toys that have switches, flaps or buttons
- Children will learn how to use simple programs
- Children will learn how to complete a simple task on an iPad

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Children will be encouraged to communicate their toileting needs
- Children will be encouraged to talk about bedtime routines and the importance of sleep
- Children will be encouraged to talk about people who are special to them (family)
