Communication, Language and Literacy

READING

We will read books from different cultures:

- The Proudest Blue
- The Ugly Duckling

WRITING

We will learn about:

- Stories from other cultures
- Poetry
- Non-fiction (explanation texts, non-chronological reports)

HANDWRITING

- We will continue to learn how to join our letters correctly, including diagonal and horizontal joins.

Mathematics

We will learn about:

- Number - looking at inverse relationships between addition and subtraction, 4 operations (particularly multiplication and division), counting in steps of 2, 3 and 5 from 0
- Place Value - using place value to solve problems
- Arithmetic – solving missing number calculations
- Measures – time problems, comparing & ordering length, mass and volume, reading scales
- Fractions – looking at equivalent fractions and $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{2}{4}$, $\frac{3}{4}$ of numbers
- Problem solving – using multiplication and division, solving practical problems involving addition and subtraction of money of the same unit, including change given
- Geometry – sorting and comparing 2D and 3D shapes, looking for 2D faces on 3D shapes.

- We will design, make and evaluate our own puppet (textiles)

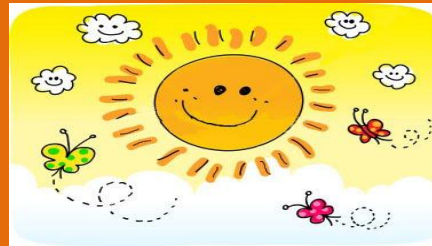
